For Doctors, Nurses and technicians in Acute care settings, e.g. ED, ICU/CCU, Theatre/PACU, Duty Nurses and Flexi nurses. All Taupo hospital Nurses and Doctors should attend.

**COURSE OBJECTIVES:** To enhance confidence with DRSABCD approach and skills of assessment and intervention. Also includes recognition of the deteriorating patient and initiating appropriate interventions via a team based approach.

There is a pre-reading workbook which is sent out 3 weeks prior to the course. During the course there are scenarios, and practice sessions on CPR, AED, Airway to LMA, Manual defib and basic rhythm recognition. There is a short multiple choice exam.

The competency last for 3 years—basic CPR must be completed in the alternate years.
