What the app will mean for you:

- Training delivered by at Te Whatu ora Lakes will be advertised in the calendar.
- The training calendar will allow you to download a calendar appointment directly into your phone calendar
- View room locations at Rotorua and Taupo hospitals
- Subscribe to special interests and unit groups and receive alerts when education is delivered about these subscriptions.
- Notify the facilitator directly from your phone if you are unable to attend a course.
- Receive alerts about other education of interest

How do you join the app?

To download the app:

- Click here to download the app on your phone Or scan the QR code
- You will be asked to search for your department search for 'Lakes District Health Board'
 - Log in using you're the provided username and the password. Once you log in for the first time your password will be saved and you will not have to enter it again.
- You will then be asked to subscribe to alerts of your choice. You control how many notifications you get.







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Midwifery Council Recertification Requirements

Mandatory Education

- Midwifery Emergency Skills Refresher (MESR) This is the practical/ hands on day refreshing management of emergency situations. REMAINS ANNUAL. The PROMPT course once every 3 years is an alternative (if doing PROMPT, separate NLS is required either full day or as a refresher which is part of the MESR workshop).
- Newborn Life Support (NLS) also remains an ANNUAL requirement for all midwives. At Te Whatu Ora -Lakes, a full day is required once every 3 years with an NLS refresher in the years in between. NLS refreshers for midwives are now part of MESR or Combined emergency skills day.
- Attend a minimum of 8 hours MIDWIFERY-FOCUSED education. EACH YEAR.
- Engage in PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES of a minimum of 8 hours. EACH YEAR.
- Participate in Midwifery Standards Review once EVERY 3 YEARS (starts from your next review). Different for new graduates/overseas midwives.
- Complete the Introduction to the Abortion Legislation and Midwifery Roles & Responsibilities 4 hour online learning package <a href="https://midwiferycouncil.health.nz/Public/06.-l-am-a-registered-midwife/Midwifery-Led-Abortion-Care-Consultation/Midwifery%20Abortion%20Core%20Education.aspx?WebsiteKey=f0308050-1256-4559-908a-2c0b3a7fd7e5

Following on from the previous recertification cycle, - as a reminder:

- Breastfeeding as a mandatory recertification requirement has been removed. (There is still a BFHI mandatory requirement however for DHB staff. These hours can go towards your Midwifery focused elective education requirement).
- Workshops no longer have points attached, and instead will be based on hours. A full day workshop will be 8 hours. Midwives should note that the requirement set by Midwifery Council is a MINIMUM of 8 hours each year. Remember to upload all midwifery related education to your Midwifery Council CPD record.
- Remember permanently employed midwives can apply for CPD funds (\$1000 pa) via MERAS CPD APPLICATION FORM (EDMS# 2635768)
