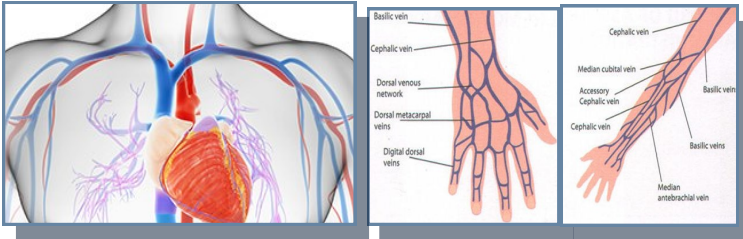


2022 Cannulation (PIVCS) and Central Venous access devices (CVAD)
